## VISA Information sheet

### Short Stay – Truck Drivers

Netherlands, Belgium, Luxembourg

### Apply for a visa

The visa department is open from Monday to Friday from 8.30 am to 11.30 am. The visa department is closed on local and Dutch public holidays. All visa applicants have to make an appointment by internet or telephone. Without an appointment you are unfortunately not able to introduce your visa request! It is advisable to apply in time (at least 2 weeks to 1 month in advance) in order to have your visa application processed. After your application has been registered the process takes at least 3 working days.

Please note that you have to apply for a visa in person.

### Schengen Visas

The Schengen visa is valid for the following countries:

*Austria, Belgium, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Italy, Luxembourg, The Netherlands, Portugal, Spain, Sweden, Iceland and Norway, Estonia, Lithuania, Latvia, Poland, Czech Republic, Slovakia, Hungary, Slovenia and Malta*

A Schengen visa issued by an Embassy or Consulate of one of the Schengen countries allows the holder to travel freely in these countries. However, please note that a holder of a Schengen visa is still subject to immigration control and is *not guaranteed* entry into any of the Schengen countries; a visa is not in itself a right to enter a country. Please check the information sheet 'Traveling with a valid Schengen Visa' that you will receive while picking up your visa, very carefully!

### Where should I apply?

- If you intend to visit only one of the Schengen countries, you *must* apply for a visa at the Embassy or Consulate of that country.
- If you intend to visit several of the Schengen countries, you must apply for a visa at the Embassy or Consulate of the country in which your **main** destination will be, or, in case there is no main destination, the first Schengen country of entry.

### General requirements

#### General requirements + Identity

a passport valid for at least three months longer than the validity of the visa, with at least two blank visa pages.  
one application form duly completed and signed by the applicant  
one passport size photograph in colour, with a light background  
handling fee for visa application (if applicable)

#### Means of support

upon approval of the visa application, proof of travel insurance (including international health coverage) which is valid for all Schengen-countries has to be presented.

#### Proof of intention to return

if you are employed, a letter from your employer, if self-employed, proof of registration of your company (+ M1/M2 form and a complete list of drivers).  
CEMT certificate/bilateral transport licence  
Actual freight documents

#### Purpose of the journey (*facilitation*)

- A written request from the national Association (union) of carriers of the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia providing for international road transportation, stating the purpose, duration and frequency of the trips.

*Depending on the circumstance of your application, you may be required to produce further documentation.  
It is essential to apply for a visa well in advance (2 weeks to 1 month) of your trip, as it may take some time to process an application.*
